Mission Statement

The Delta Kappa Gamma Society International promotes professional and personal growth of women educators and excellence in education.

Purposes

1. *to unite women educators of the world in a genuine spiritual fellowship;*
2. *to honor women who have given or who evidence a potential for distinctive service in any field of education;*
3. *to advance the professional interest and position of women in education;*
4. *to initiate, endorse, and support desirable legislation or other suitable endeavors in the interests of education and of women educators;*
- *5. to endow awards to aid members in pursuing personal and professional growth and to provide grants to non-member educators;**
- *6. to stimulate the personal and professional development of members and to encourage their participation in relevant programs of action;**
7. *to inform the members of current economic, social, political, and educational issues so that they may participate effectively to support a sustainable world society*

Scholarship applicant seeking financial assistance with educational growth must be an active Upsilon Chapter member for a minimum of two years to be eligible for this scholarship. Scholarship funding can be used for:

- college classes
- classes toward advanced degrees such as a Masters or Doctorate
- Leadership or educational conferences
- PTSB or certificate renewal classes
- Personal growth (computer class, financial planning, etc....)
- Professional Certification testing

All awarded funds must be applied toward current or future programs or classes.

DKG Upsilon has a budget of \$5,000 per year to award members. Each member may receive up to \$1,500 per year, not to exceed \$6,000 over a 5 year period. Scholarships will be accepted and awarded throughout each fiscal year of July 1st through June 30th.

Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee, and if recommended sent to the Executive Board for approval by vote. Notification of application outcome will be as soon as possible. Scholarships awarded will then be announced to the membership, including recognition at the Founder's Day and State DKG meetings.

Completed applications are evaluated as they are received. Availability of funds may limit the amount of some awards and the processing time necessary. Funds will be awarded in the form of a check payable to the scholarship awardee.
